Leak Busters

What is the *Leak Busters* program?

The Leak Buster patch program will teach Brownie Girl Scouts to understand where water comes from, how it is stored and utilized, how much they use on a daily basis and how they can help to conserve it. By **discovering** the value of water, **connecting** to how water is used, and sometimes wasted, and **taking action** to save water and educate others on how to do the same, your Brownie Girl Scouts will help to make the world a better place.

How does the *Leak Busters* program work with the Girl Scouts?

You can choose to participate in the program at your own troop meeting. You can also choose to participate in a one-day event offered during the 2008-2009 Girl Scout year.

What is included in the *Leak Busters* program?

The Leak Buster program for Brownie Girl Scouts includes a leader guide filled with four activities that can be done with your girls.

How do I request the *Leak Busters* program?
