Mrs. Girlscout has done an outstanding job as Chairperson of Borough Events Committee. When she assumed that position, the events committee had been neglected for many years. In February 2000, Mrs. Girlscout reorganized the Borough committee of 12 members and together with the committee, organized an event that attracted 5000 participants. At the same time, she worked on creating two patch programs for the girls, which were submitted to Council and approved. To date, over 500 girls in the Borough have worked toward both patch programs. Under Mrs. Girlscout’s direction, the Borough Events Committee is “full steam” ahead.

In our Service Unit, Mrs. Girlscout has recruited and retained more leaders than we expected, two troops went to Virginia with her advice and help and the amount of Daisy troops has tripled. She is well respected in the community by local civic leaders and school professionals and is loved by the girls and leaders.
