The Juliette Low Society honors forward-thinking individuals who have included the Girl Scout Council of Greater New York in their estate plans. You can become a member of the Juliette Low Society by:

- ***Naming the Girl Scout Council of Greater New York in a will or in a revocable trust.***

If you are considering including the Girl Scout Council of Greater New York in your will, the following suggested language should be shared with your attorney:

*"I give, devise and bequeath to the Girl Scout Council of Greater New York, the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ (or otherwise describe the gift or specify a percentage of the estate) to be used for its general purposes."*

- ***Naming the Girl Scout Council of Greater New York as the beneficiary of a new or existing life insurance policy.***

- ***Establishing a trust or annuity that will provide you or someone important to you with income for life.***

Charitable gift annuities (CGAs) will soon be available to benefit the Girl Scout Council of Greater New York. CGAs enable donors over 55 to receive income for life, some of which is tax free, and to get an income tax deduction and favorable capital gains tax treatment. There is no fee to the donor for establishing a CGA.

- ***Participating in the Girl Scout of the USA's pooled income fund for the benefit of the Girl Scout Council of Greater New York.***

Current interest rates do not make this an attractive option for most donors, but it is available for those who wish to participate.
