## **2010 Carmen Dubroc Bright Future Scholarship**

This college scholarship is available to any registered Girl Scout ages 14 to 17 interested in pursuing a career in the arts, education, civil service or the nonprofit sector. The winner will be awarded the scholarship no more than one time.

### **Selection Process:**

A committee will review the applications and essay to determine a group of finalists. The final candidates will be asked to come to the Council for interviews. Based on the combination of an application, essay and interview, the Committee will determine the recipient of the 2009 Carmen Dubroc Bright Future Scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded at the Gold Award Ceremony in June and payment will be made directly to the college or university by the Girl Scout Council of Greater New York on behalf of the recipient.

### **Criteria for Participation:**

Each applicant must:

- Be a registered Girl Scout between the ages 14 and 17 as of March 1st, 2010.
- Be bound for higher education in one of the following fields: the arts, education, civil service or non-profit service.
- Have a dynamic Girl Scout history, though not necessarily a long one.
- Demonstrate community service and participation in extracurricular activities.
- Demonstrate leadership ability.
- Show a strong commitment to Girl Scouting and the Girl Scout Promise and Law.
