

# Summer Camp Sleep Away Adventure

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: What is your new Sleep Away Adventure?**

**A:** Sleep Away Adventure is for girls age nine to sixteen. We are offering two one-week sessions of traditional camping experiences. Throughout the week, they will work towards badges and interest projects and take part in environmental awareness projects. The girls will live with their peers and be supervised at all times by trained counselors. Activities will be led by qualified instructors and girls will be able to experience the joy of sleep away camp, while parents can rest assured that their girls are living and learning in a nurturing environment. You can sign your daughter up for one or both sessions.

**Q: What are the dates and fees for the two one-week sessions of Sleep Away Adventure?**

**A:** We are offering two one-week sessions on the following dates:

- Session One: June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2009 – July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009
- Session Two: July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009 – July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2009
- Combined Session: Sunday, June 28<sup>th</sup> to Friday, July 10<sup>th</sup>

**Q: How do I get a registration form for Summer Camp Sleep Away Adventure?**

**A:** You can sign your daughter up for one or both weeks. The Brochure is posted on the website and the registration form starts on page 9. If you cannot obtain the brochure off the web, please leave a message on the Camp Hotline at 212-645-4000 ext 336 with your name and address requesting a copy. PLEASE READ THE BROCHURE IN ITS ENTIRETY TO ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE ALL THE INFORMATION YOU NEED.

**Q: Can a spot for the Sleep Away Adventure be reserved prior to submitting a registration form and deposit?**

**A:** Spots cannot be reserved prior to submitting a form and deposit, but there are a few ways to increase the likelihood of getting a preferred session:

- Check the web: Bi-weekly, a posting will be made available of the sessions that are still open.
- Make sure that your application is filled out completely with your deposit. Incomplete applications and/or applications with insufficient funds will be returned without reserving your space at camp.

\*Please keep in mind what is open today maybe closed tomorrow. There is no way to guarantee that a session will still be open by the time we receive the application.

**Q: Is Financial Aid available for Sleep Away Adventure?**

**A:** YES! We have a limited amount of Financial Aid available for girls. All you have to do is complete the Financial Aid form can be obtained off the Girl Scouts website at [www.girlscoutsnyc.org](http://www.girlscoutsnyc.org). Remember that leaving answers blank will affect the amount you are rewarded. (Please refer to page 2 of brochure for further information).

**Q: After submitting my registration form, and receiving a confirmation email, is it too late to add girls to a session?**

**A:** If the session is still open, we can add girls. Here is the procedure to follow: Submit your request in writing, listing the number of additional girls. You may mail, email or fax the information along with their camp deposit of \$50.00 per camper (if camping session is less than 3 weeks away, additional girls must pay camp fee in full) in order to secure their spot. Credit card payments are now accepted.

**Q: Can I cancel my reservation or replace a girl who cannot attend with another girl?**

**A:** Please refer to the Refund Policy on page 3 of the brochure for a detailed explanation.

**Q: What is the cost of **Sleep Away Adventure**?**

**A:**

\$350 per girl for the 5 day session if register by April 15<sup>th</sup> or \$380 per girls after April 15<sup>th</sup>  
\$490 per girl for the 7 day session if register by April 15 or \$520 per girl after April 15<sup>th</sup>  
\$800 per girl for both sessions if registered by April 15<sup>th</sup> and \$840 per girl after April 15<sup>th</sup>

Early Bird registration on Saturday February 2<sup>nd</sup> registers on that day and receive a \$5 discount.

**Q: Can my daughter bunk with her friends?**

**A:** Some girls come to Sleep Away Camp individually, some come with their best friend and others come with their troop. Our aim is to give girls new experiences and for them to make new friends. Each girl can choose one camp buddy if requested beforehand. We do not place entire groups together, experience tells that girls have a more rounded experience when they meet new girls and do not stay with the girls they know

**Q: How can we obtain information regarding our daughter's program for the session?**

**A:** All of this information including your daughter's program, lodging, and balance information will be sent to you in a confirmation packet, confirming your plans a few weeks before your daughter's camping session. The confirmation packet is an essential piece of your trip that should be read thoroughly prior to arrival in order to inform you of all camp policies and standard procedures.

**Q: I have a question that has not been listed, who do I contact to find the answer?**

**A:** The Camp Hotline at 212-645-4000 ext 336 is an excellent method of communication between yourself and camp staff. Just leave us a message including your name, number and your camping weekend if you have one, and we will return your call in 48 (*business*) hours or less. Please remember to leave your daytime or cell phone number where you can be reached between 9am to 5pm. Also, read the Summer Camp Brochure, it is full of very useful information that may help you.
