- C. Discuss the personal strengths, talents, and skills that will be put into action.
- D. Is this a joint project? (*It is strongly recommended that no more than three girls work together on a project.*)
 - If yes, please list the Girl Scout(s) that will complete the project with you.
 - Describe what will be your specific responsibility when completing this project.
- E. Describe the steps you will take to put your plan into action.
 - Develop or include the timeline you created with your advisor.
 - Include information about facilities and/or equipment you will need.
- F. Explain how you will evaluate the effectiveness/success of your project.
 - Describe the specific ways you will evaluate your work. (For example: surveys, evaluation forms, number of participants, etc.)
- G. List the names of and positions of experts/advisors/consultants and resources you plan to use. Describe how these resources will help you.
- H. Estimate overall project expenses.
 - Attach a copy of your proposed budget.
 - Indicate how you plan to meet these costs.
